- ➤ improve the **soft skills** of those participating, such as communication skills, self-confidence, and working in a team

- ➤ Participants will be working both individually and in a group, both at the Sixth Form's campus and outside.
- > One or more group activities relating to the different cultures of those participating will be organised with the input of the participants themselves.
- > Participants will organise a portfolio.
